

## **CITY OF BOCA RATON NOTICE OF BOARD VACANCIES**

The City Council of the City of Boca Raton will be interviewing applicants to fill vacancies on the following Boards:

### **BOCA RATON ADVISORY BOARD FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES**

Residency in City not required.

Makes recommendations to the City Council regarding issues confronting people with disabilities, and seek to educate the public on such issues.

### **BUILDERS' BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND APPEALS**

Must be a City resident and either a state-registered architect, state-registered engineer, state-registered general contractor or a member-at-large.

Hears and rules on appeals of decisions of the City's fire and building officials.

### **CITIZENS' PEDESTRIAN AND BIKEWAY ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a City resident and a qualified elector of the City.

Assists in implementing a pedestrian and bikeway system consistent with the requirements of the City's Comprehensive Plan.

### **CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD**

Must be a City resident and an engineer.

Conducts hearings related to enforcement of various occupational licenses and fire, building, zoning, sign and technical codes of the City in order to protect and improve the health, safety and welfare of the citizenry.

### **DOWNTOWN BOCA RATON ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Must be a resident or property owner, business owner, or store owner in the Community Redevelopment Area.

Provides input and recommendations to the City Council and the Community Redevelopment Agency regarding the present and future redevelopment of downtown Boca Raton.

### **ELDER AFFAIRS ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a resident and a qualified elector of the City of Boca Raton.

Develops and offers recommendations to the City Council for policies, programs and legislation that supports elders and their needs.

### **LIBRARY ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a City resident.

Makes recommendations to City Council regarding management and operation of municipal libraries.

### **MARINE ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a resident and a qualified elector of the City of Boca Raton.

Must be affiliated with the Boca Raton Coast Guard Auxiliary or a unit owner of a condominium (primary residence) adjacent to an inland waterway; owner may be a boater or non-boater. Makes recommendations to City Council regarding issues related to waterways within the City of Boca Raton.

### **SPECIAL MASTER**

Must be a retired Florida Judge; or be a member in good standing of the Florida Bar, with practice substantially in the area of administrative, governmental, zoning, land use or real estate law.

Conducts hearings regarding testimony and evidence on said code violations, and render orders of enforcement in accordance with City of Boca Raton Ordinance 4494.
